



ANTIQUE BEAM-SAWN OAK

Wide Plank Flooring Description

- **Species:** Mixed Red & White Oak planks
- **Source:** Primarily resawn from reclaimed barn beams
- **Heartwood:** 90% and better
- **Knots:** Sound knots and maybe some partially broken knots
- **Holes:** Scattered nail / spike holes and possibly some larger plugged holes. Also may have occasional worm hole patterns and insect scars
- **Cracks:** Aging cracks are allowed as long as the plank is stable and usable.
- **Face Character:** Surface of planks has limited patina along with very limited original weathering or saw marks
- **Color:** Natural color variations including: browns, tan, some reddish hews
- **Grain:** Mixed grain patterns
- **Milling:** Tongue & Groove profile with back relief and end-matched.
- **Size:** Thickness: $\frac{3}{4}$ " Width: 3" - 12" Wider widths from 12" - 18" are available in a "butt joint" plank profile (square edges). Length: Random
- **M/C:** 8-10% or less
